

Professor Mika Kivimaki at University College London is the director of the Whitehall II study, a cohort study of British civil servants who have been followed up with clinical examinations every five years since 1985. He is also the principal investigator of the Individual-Participant-Data Metaanalysis in Working Populations (IPD-Work) consortium of 17 European cohort studies and a senior author of scientific papers from multiple other research consortia, including the EU Horizon 2020 LIFEPATH project. The overarching aim of his research is to increase understanding on adulthood risk factors for impaired functioning and common chronic conditions, such as cardiovascular diseases, type 2 diabetes and depression.
